## LIFE'S UNRESOLVED MYSTERIES

## Ecclesiastes 8:10-17

MAIN IDEA: There are mysteries of life which may never be fully resolved this side of heaven.

- I. MYSTERY #1: WHY DO THE WICKED SEEM TO BE IMPROPERLY COMPENSATED IN SPITE OF THEIR WICKEDNESS? (Eccl. 8:10-13)
  - A. What appears as vanity (8:10-12a): apparent blessing on the wicked (cp. Psa. 73:1-12)
    - Their name praised (8:10)
    - Their sin not *punished* (8:11)
    - Their days *prolonged* (8:12)
  - B. What stands as truth (8:12b-13): certain judgment on the wicked (cp. Psa. 37:1, 8-22, 34-38; 73:16-20)
    - Blessing on the righteous--because they fear God (8:12b)
    - Judgment on the wicked--because they don't fear God (8:13)
      - > End of wellness
      - > End of days
- II. MYSTERY #2: WHY DOES THE <u>TREATMENT</u> OF MEN NOT SEEM TO BE CLOSELY COMPATIBLE WITH THEIR CHARACTER? (Eccl.8:14-15)
  - A. What appears as vanity (8:14): treatment doesn't fit character (cp. Eccl. 2:12-16; 7:15; 9:2-3)
    - The righteous experiencing what the wicked deserve (8:14a)
    - The wicked experiencing what the rigtheous deserve (8:14b)
  - B. What stands as truth (8:15): enjoy the life which God has given (cp. 2:24-26; 3:12-13,22; 5:18-20; 9:7-9; 11:8-10).
    - Not a justification to "live it up" (cp. Luke 12:16-20)
    - An exhortation to enjoy life which God has given (cp. I Tim. 6:17)
      - Accepting life as a special gift from God
      - > Enjoyment as gift from God even in difficult circumstances
      - > Thankfulness and contentment instead of complaining
- III. MYSTERY #3: WHY DOES THE WORK OF GOD NOT SEEM TO BE CLEARLY COMPREHENDED BY MAN? (Eccl. 8:16-17)
  - A. What appears as vanity (8:16-17): the inability to comprehend all that God is doing under the sun (cp. 3:11; 7:14, 24, 27-28)
    - The intensity of the search: great effort given (8:16)
    - The result of the search: inability to find the answers (8:17)
  - B. What stands as truth (8:17): man's limited knowledge
    - Admitting my own lack of knowledge
    - Trusting and fearing God who knows and governs all (cp. 8:12)
- Issues unresolved will be resolved someday.
- Justice unenforced will be enforced someday.
- \* Questions unanswered will be answered someday.
