LIVING NOW IN LIGHT OF YOUR FUTURE DEATH Ecclesiastes 9:1-10

MAIN IDEA: Looking at the end of your life should drastically affect how you live the rest of your life.

I. OBSERVATIONS ABOUT LIFE AND DEATH (Eccl. 9:1-6)

- A. There is an accountability which both the righteous and the wise have (9:1).
 - We are in the *hands* of God—He is in *control*.
 - We don't know what awaits us.
- B. There is an appointment which both the righteous and the wicked have (9:2-3; cp. Heb. 9:27).

"All things come alike to all" (cp. 2:14-15; 8:14).

- No matter their character, all men have a common *destiny* on earth: *death* (9:2-3a).
- Before they die, men reveal the wickedness of their heart (9:3b).
- C. There is an advantage which the living have over the dead (9:4-6).
 - In the realm of what they *anticipate* (9:4)
 - In the realm of what they *know* (9:5a)
 - In the realm of what they receive (9:5b)
 - In the realm of what they *feel* (9:6a)
 - In the realm of what they *experience* (9:6b)

II. OPPORTUNITIES IN LIFE . . . BEFORE DEATH (Eccl. 9:7-10)

- A. Enjoy the life which God has given you (9:7-8; cp. 2:24-26; 3:12-13,22; 5:18-20; 8:15; 11:8-10).
 - Enjoy the material *blessings* (9:7a).
 - Enjoy the spiritual acceptance (9:7b).
 - Enjoy the special *occasions* (9:8).
- B. Enjoy the love of your wife (9:9; cp. Prov. 5:15-20).
 - God has instituted marriage (cp. Gen. 2:18-24; Heb. 13:4).
 - God has designed marriage for enjoyment (cp. Prov. 5:15-20).
- C. Enjoy the labor of your hands (9:10; cp. Col. 3:17, 23-24).
 - The manner: do it with all your might (cp. Col. 3:23-24).
 - The motivation: death marks an end of all earthly opportunities and service (cp. John 9:4; II Cor. 5:10).
- ❖ Instead of worrying about the future and death, enjoy the life God has given.
- * Instead of wasting opportunities, put all your energy into serving the Lord.
- Instead of working only for earthly rewards, invest your effort in eternal things
